"Purple-colored, it displays a fragrant perfume of pain grille, pencil lead, scorched earth, violets, cassis, and black currant. On the palate it is more austere than the Cabernet Franc as well as more structured. Nevertheless, it has plenty of savory red and black fruit, enough tannin for balance, and a lengthy finish. Give it 3-4 years of additional cellaring and drink it from 2013 to 2026." ~ Jay Miller
