Tasting Notes

This vintage presents itself with a medium to dark ruby color. On the nose one is reminded of raspberry jam as well as dark vine fruit, blackberry and cassis. There is also a hint of white pepper and leather hidden beneath the layers of fresh fruit.

The approach is driven with generous amounts of fresh berries, vanilla, cocoa and chocolate. This wine has adequate tannin and fruit to create a big red wine experience. You will find its best performance by serving it with a hearty cheese platter or any red meat of your choosing.
