Tasting Notes

Dressed in a deep golden straw color with a bright and brilliant hue, the nose offers generous amounts of green apple, citrus, melon, and a hint of tropical fruit. The approach is full and explosive in the mouth with a lively acidity due to the stainless steel fermentation. Adding to its pleasure is a creamy underlying note of vanilla from the French oak staves used in addition to the stainless. The finish is long and lazy in perfect harmony between fruit and acidity.
