Tasting Notes

This year's Winemaker's Red shows a clear, bright, ruby-red color. The aromas hearken to its predecessor with Caramel, a bit of dark berry and cherry and a hint of smoke and lilac. On the palate a medium to light acidity comes through as cranberry to compliment the caramel, coffee and bits of chocolate.
